Intake Services

Intake coordinators provide mental health screenings and assessments to determine an individual's service needs. Through the completion of a psychosocial assessment, Intake coordinators can link and refer individuals to desired Mental Health services and community resources, including Administrative Case Management.

Intake coordinators accept referral calls and provide screenings/assessments for Mental Health, Early Intervention, and Mental Retardation

Intake assessments are free to persons served, confidential, and are voluntary.

Intake assessments can be completed in the office or on a mobile basis at community providers, hospitals, or correctional facilities.

Requests for an Intake Assessment can be made by the person to be served, family, schools, mental health providers, children and youth services, probation, hospitals and community agencies.

If you would like an intake, call or visit a SAM office between 8:30am and 5:00pm Monday through Friday. Sites are available in Huntingdon, Mifflin, and Juniata Counties.

Administrative Case Management Services *for Children & Adults*

Administrative Case Managers (ACM) provide case management services and referrals to individuals in need of therapy, medications, psych rehab services, advocacy and/or support.

ACM assists persons served and family in identifying and accessing community resources and providers of Mental Health treatment.

ACM acts as an advocate and liaison for our persons served and family involved with other community and support agencies.

ACM assists and supports persons served and family in establishing and reaching personal goals.

ACM services are free to persons served, confidential, and are voluntary.

ACM is helpful for those who are just beginning mental health treatment services, or for those who would like to again become involved in those services, and do not have insurance or Medical Assistance Benefits.

Served individuals meet with their ACM at least once every year
