SAM, Inc. makes referrals and authorizes for services within their network of contracted providers.

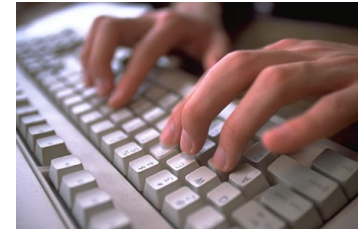

INTAKE

The Intake Unit provides intake, screening, and referral for adults and children eligible for Mental Health Services within the County of Schuylkill. If you would like an intake, call the SAM office between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday and ask for an appointment. If you require special accommodations, please inform us of this prior to your appointment. Please bring your insurance card to the appointment if you have insurance. Pay stubs, tax returns, real estate and school tax receipts will be helpful in determining a fee if you have one. It is important to bring a list of medications that your physician prescribes for you.

You can receive administrative casemanagement if you have an active case with SAM, Inc. Your casemanager will assist you in completing a service plan and annual update. They can also assist you with accessing services.
