# Supports Coordination Services for Adults and Children

## Mental Retardation System Principals

The Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) supports making “Everyday Lives” a reality for people we support. SAM, Inc. applies the following ODP principals to our services:

- Be provided in a person and family driven system
- Promote individuality, choice, and control
- Meet state and federal statutes to ensure continuity of funding for services
- Ensure health and safety of all individuals
- Be monitored for quality and satisfaction

## Who is Eligible for Services?

- Individuals with a diagnosis of Mental Retardation. Documentation must include an IQ of 70 or below.
- Eligibility for certain services is dependent upon income and asset requirements.
- Eligibility can be determined in the intake process at SAM, Inc.

## What are Supports Coordination Services?

- Advocacy of Individual rights
- Development and maintenance of an Individual Support Plan (ISP).
- Determining the need for services and developing “outcomes.”
- Identifying and locating providers of services.
- Coordinating waiver services when funding is available.
- Ensuring services are received as outlined in the ISP.
- Ensuring health and safety.

## How Do I Access Mental Retardation Supports Coordination Services?

To see if you or your family member is eligible for Mental Retardation Services, call one of our three offices in Huntingdon, Mifflin, and Juniata Counties and ask to speak with an Intake Worker.

## What Additional Services can be Provided?

Community services and resources that do not require Medicaid Waiver slots and funding can be explored for all individuals receiving Supports Coordination services.

Pending availability of Medicaid Waiver slots and funding, these are some of the services that can be added to ISPs and provided based on approval by the Juniata Valley Tri-County MH/MR program:

- Residential Services
  - Community Homes
  - Life Sharing
  - Supported Living
- Day Services
  - Adult Training Programs
  - Vocational Training Programs
  - Job Finding and Job Support
- Home Based Services
  - Habilitation
  - Respite
  - Minor Home and Vehicle Renovations/  
Adaptations
